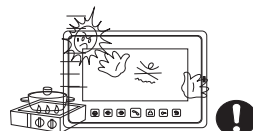
If the socket holes are larger than normal, do not put the plug.

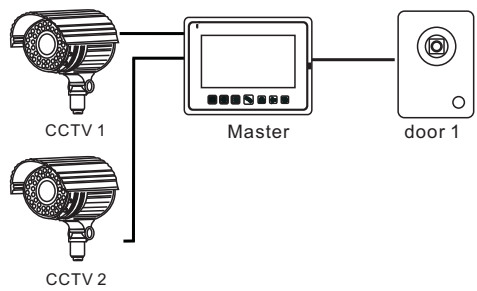
System layout

1.The port 3 connect CCTV camera

(a)Port 2 connect door panel. The system can maximum support 2 door panels and 1 CCTVcamera.

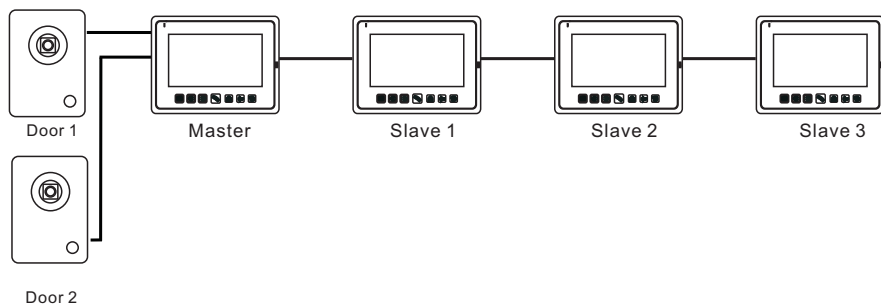


(b)Port 2 connect CCTV camera. The system can maximum support 1 door panel and 2 CCTVcameras.

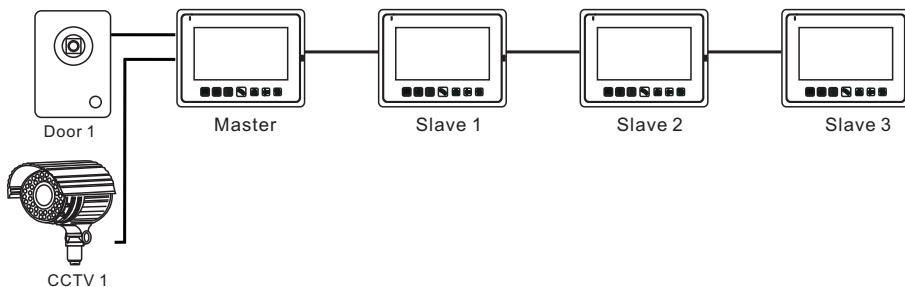


2.The port 3 connect the slave machine

(a)Port 2 connect door panel. The system can maximum support 1 master monitor , 2 door panels and 3 slave monitors .



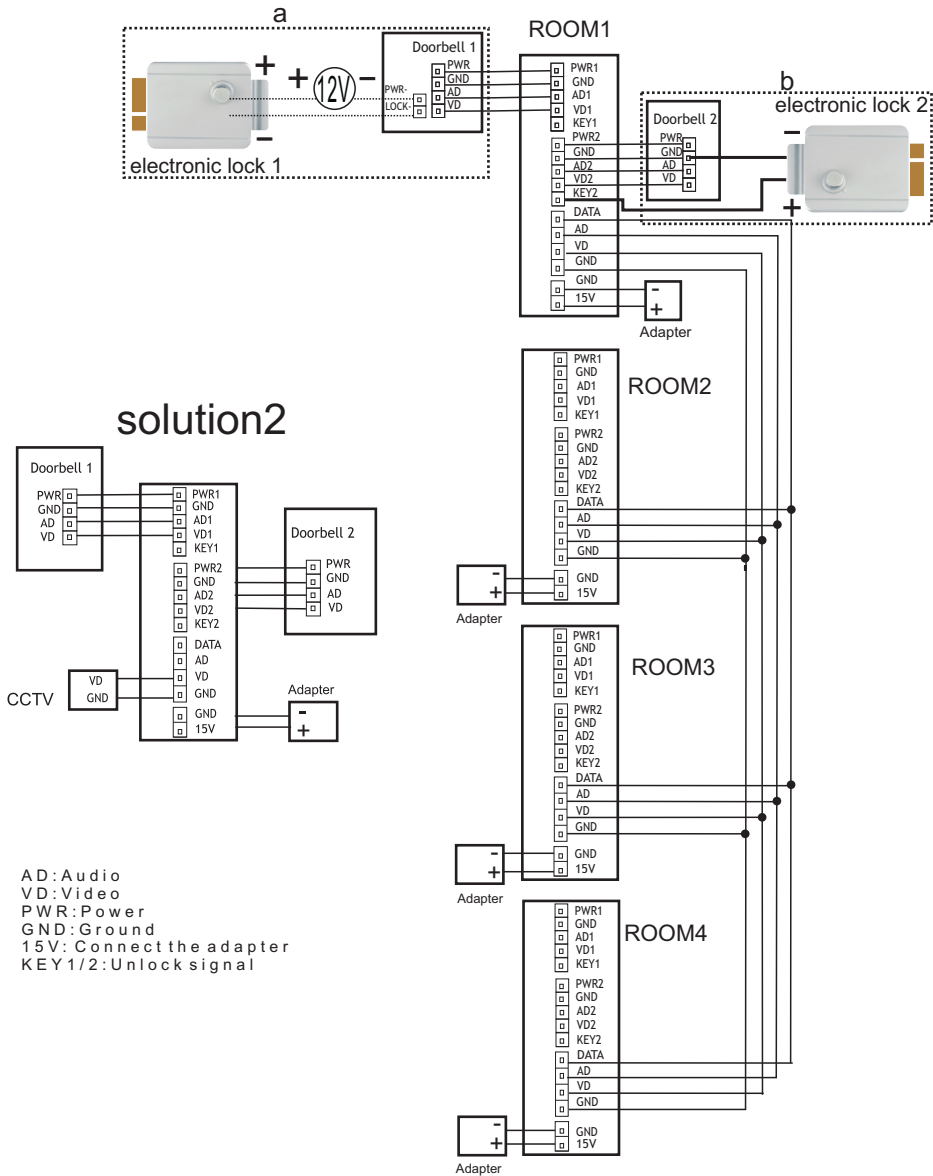
(b)Port 2 connect CCTV camera. The system can maximum support 1master monitor , 1 door panel ,1CCTV camera and 3 slave monitors .

Wiring diagram

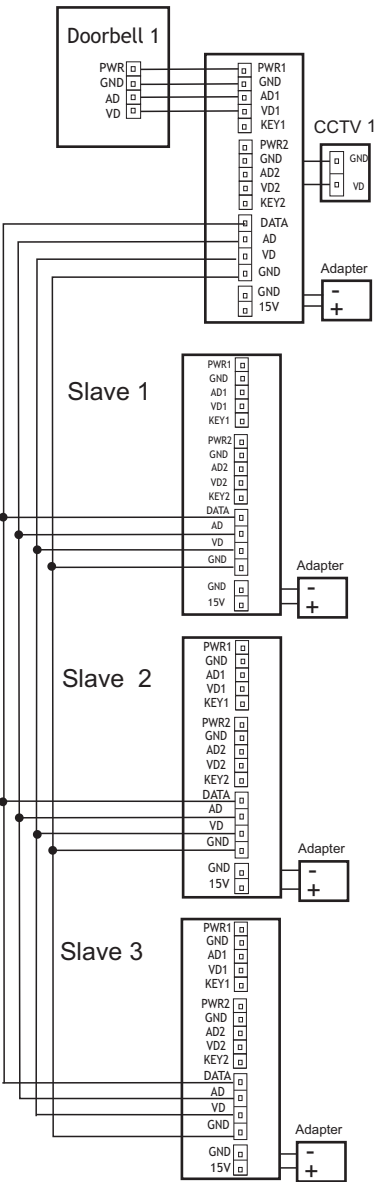

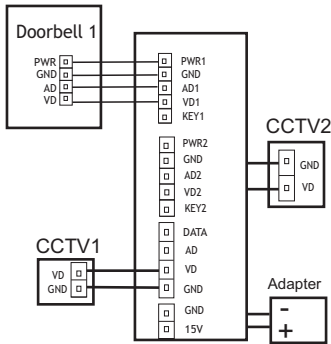
Note: (a)Door panel unlock wiring: electronic lock 1+external power supply.

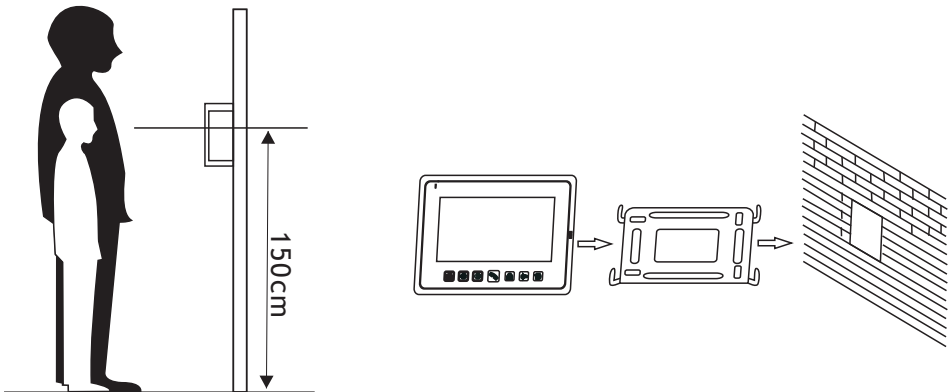

Installation method

- 1.Refer to relevant wiring diagram for the system you have chosen and ensure you have the correct cable.
- 2.Determine Monitor positions and heights:
 - suggest to install at 1.5~1.6Meters;
 - suggest distance between indoor monitor and doorbell is at least 350 mm;
- 3.Ensure no power supply connection before installation finished
- 4.Take off the bracket from the back of the monitor.
- 5.Install the bracket on the wall
- 6.Connect cables as per the wiring diagram indicated.
- 7.Fix the monitor onto the bracket.
- 8.Connect power when doorbell is installed.

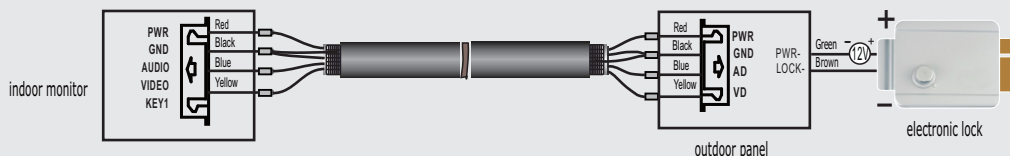


Cable specification

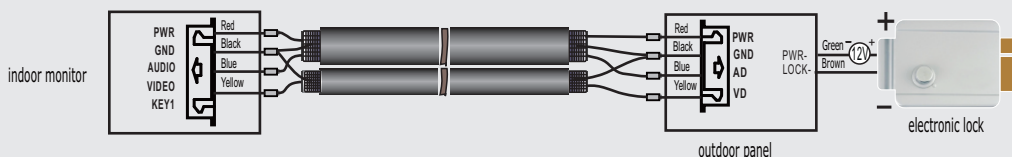
Our system has 2 solutions to unlock the door: Unlock signal from doorbell or unlock signal from monitor.(The cable shield wire needs to be grounded)

When signal from the doorbell,cable specification is:

- Distance between monitor and door station is less than 30 meters,shielded 4*0.5 mm² cable is available:

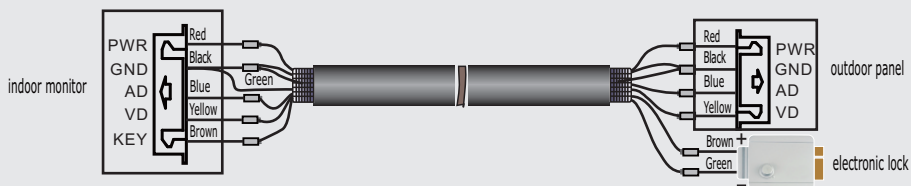


- Distance exceed 30 meters,please choose professional cable SYV-75-3+RVVP 2*0.5mm² (recommend);

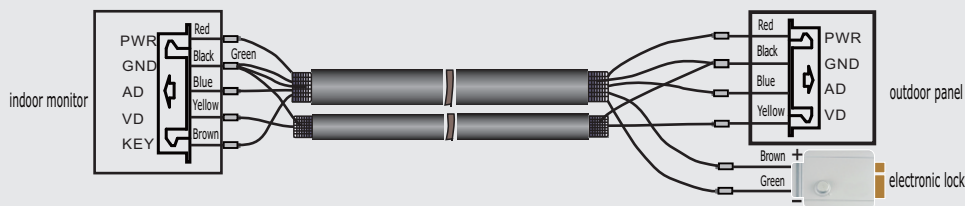


When signal is from monitor,cable specification is:



- Distance between monitor and door station is less than 30 meters,shielded 6*0.5mm² cable is available;





- Distance exceed 30 meters,please choose professional cable SYV-75-3+RVVP 4*0.5mm² (recommend).







Incoming call answer

When a visitor presses doorbell, all the indoor monitors in this house will chime simultaneously, the screen will show INCOMING CALL. Press  to talk with the visitor(talk time is 60 seconds). If you want to unlock the door for the visitor, press  button, then DOOR UNLOCKED will show on the screen.






1.If there is another call incoming during conversation ,SOMEONE IS VISITING DOOR 2 will display, press  can switch to another visiting .

2.You can transfer your call to other monitors in the system while talking with the visitor. If you want to transfer the call to others, press  can transfer the call.(The words TRANSFERRING TO OTHER ROOMS will display).





Talking volume adjust

At talking/intercom state , press  or  button to enter the talking adjustment screen. The talking volume value will show on the screen. If you want to mute the microphone, press and hold the  button for 2 seconds, MUTE sign will appear on the screen. To turn the microphone on ,operate the  button in the same way.

Brightness/contrast/ color adjust


When screen is on, press  or  button to enter the adjust screen. Then press  button can switch to BRIGHT, CONT and COLOR adjust screen, press  or  to adjust the brightness ,contrast and color .

Monitor doorbells/CCTV cameras


At standby state, press  button , view images from the connected doorbell/CCTV, press  again, you can switch to other channels. When monitoring the doorbell, press , you can talk with the visitor in front of the door, press  again to open the door.

Convert image display scale between 16:9 and 4:3

Defaulted screen format is 16:9.

Sometimes, when you view images, CCTV cameras or when you talk with the visitor, the images are full screen display. Press and hold the  button for 2 seconds to convert the image display scale between 16:9 and 4:3.


“Don’t disturb” function

If you want to disable chime sound on the monitor, press and hold the  button for 2 seconds at standby state. “DO NOT DISTURB ENABLE” will show on the screen, and then the LED indicator will flickers - it means “Don’t disturb” mode is active. If you want to disable “Don’t disturb” mode, operate in the same way , “DO NOT DISTURB DISABLE” will show on the screen. The LED indicator will keep light - it means “Don’t disturb” mode is disabled. Also you can use SYSTEM SETTINGS menu to turn DO NOT DISTURB on or off.



Note: If this function enabled , there will be no chime during call incoming , intercom, broadcast ,and the buttons will keep light at the same time.

If you have more than one monitor (up to 4 monitors) in your house, you can make below operations.

Internal call among monitors


If you make intercom request for other monitors, press  at standby state.

If you have more than 2 monitors connected together, you can press  or


 to choose the target monitor NO. on the screen , then press  button to confirm the calling.

Broadcast function

This function allows you to broadcast information for all monitors in your house.

To make broadcast , press and hold the  button for 2 seconds, the screen will show BROADCAST REQUEST, the monitor in other rooms will show

BROADCASTING . Now you can make broadcast to all other monitors .Press


 to end broadcast request.

Monitor listening

At standby state, press and hold  button for 2 seconds to active monitor

listening to another monitor. if you have more than 2 indoor monitors, you can


press  or  to choose the target monitor NO. on the screen , then

press  button to confirm. Display of your monitor will show “LISTENING TO OTHER”. The maximum monitor listening time is 8 hours.

Note: CAN BE MONITORED function should be enabled in SYSTEM SETTINGS of the target monitor. If you want to deny listening of your monitor from another monitors, disable CAN BE MONITORED function in the system.

Capture images

1. Automatic image capturing: " Auto capture quantity " should be set as 1,2 or 3 in the system setting. The system can automatically take and save pictures when the doorbell calls.

2. Manual image capturing: When at answering and monitoring state, press  button to capture images manually before answer. The words IMAGES CAPTURED will show on the screen.

DVR function

Automatic DVR function :Enable DVR in SYSTEM SETTINGS to activate that function. You can record video from any doorbell or CCTV camera in your system at set time.



Note : (a) If set MOTION DETECTION SENSITIVITY to be LOW/NORMAL/HIGH, the system will record only when motion detected and last for 10 minutes after that, then it will stop recording until another motion detected.

(b) Sound doesn't record in DVR function.

(c) DVR function can not work when the TF card is less than 2G, for 2G TF card, it can only work at 1 frame/second with resolution of 320*240. For longest recording time and other parameters. Please refer to P27.

- (d) To act DVR function well, pls use the TF card with capacity of no less than 8G.
- (e) To get high quality video, We kindly recommend user setup 640*480 resolution.
- (f) When the start time and the end time are set as the same time, the DVR function will active in 24 hours immediately and last forever.
- (f) For detail information of DVR function, please refer to P20.23.24.

Manual video recording

When at the answering and monitoring state, press and hold the  button for 2 seconds to record video manually, press  button again to end the recording.






Note: View and manage video files, pls refer to P18.19.

Auto leaving message

This function let your visitors to leave a video message for you while nobody is at home. You should activate AUTO LEAVING MESSAGE function in the SYSTEM SETTINGS before leaving home. When the visitor presses call button on the door panel and the chime time ends, visitor can hear a voice "Hello, no one is at home at the moment, please leave a message after the tone" from the door panel and have 20 seconds to leave a message for you.

Note: View and manage messages and more operation, please refer to P18.19.

Family audio message

You can record audio message to your family, press and hold the  button for 2 seconds to enter the system main menu, press  or  to move the cursor to , press  to enter the message recording menu as Figure 1.

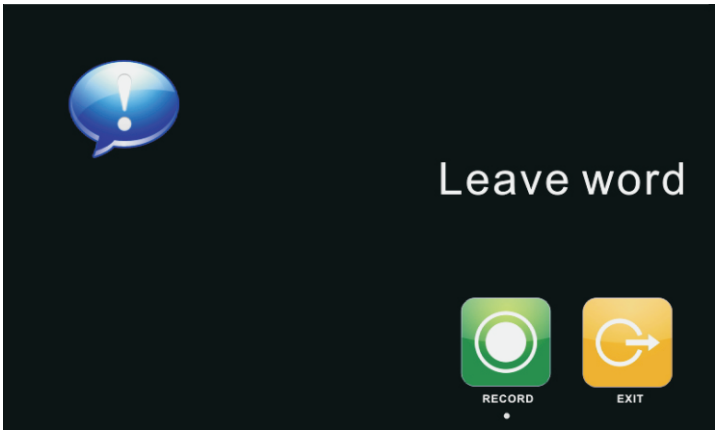

Choose “RECORD” to start recording. When the recording finished, press the button again to stop recording. If your message was recorded successfully, then choose “EXIT” to exit the recording menu.

Note: View and manage messages , please refer to P18,19.

Change attention message for AUTO LEAVING MESSSAGE function

When AUTO LEAVING MESSAGE is on, if nobody answers the call before chime time ends, the visitor will hear a voice attention message : “no one is at home at the moment, please leave a message after the tone”? If the user wants to change this attention message (BEGINNING TONE) into their own sound, please take the following steps:










Go to  menu and record one audio message, then exit record menu and enter  menu. Choose the audio file you want to set as beginning tone, press  and hold the  button for 2 seconds to enter “CONFIG ATTENTION TONE” menu as Figure 2.

Choose the TONE TYPE to change the option to be USER TONE, then choose the PLAY TYPE to change the option to be BEGINNING TONE. Also you can adjust the attention tone volume. If you finished the above operation, press  or  to choose ACT to confirm the setting. Same operation to change the ENDING TONE.

Alarm clock

Press  button to main menu, select  menu to enable ALARM CLOCK SETTING. Since set time ,it will alarm every 50 seconds till you turn the alarm clock off by press  button. Refer to P25.26 for detailed settings.

View photo , video ,DVR and audio files





1. In standby state, press  button to system main menu, if you have unread files, there will be a number on the right corner of the icon with red color, the number is the unread files' quantity. Press  or  button to choose the target icon. Then press  button to enter the related menu to review.




Note: All files names consists of the date and time it was created, for example:



2012-02-01 11:30:20, means that files was created on 11:30:20, Feb, 1st , 2012.

So it's very convenient for you to know the record time and tell the different files.

2. You can manage the files as below operations:

(a) Adjust volume when playing audio /video/DVR file: press and hold  or  for 2 seconds, the present volume value will show on the screen, press  or  to adjust the volume. (Volume can be adjust from 0 to 10.)

(b) Speed up playing video /DVR file: press and hold  button for 2 seconds, the playing will be speed up to 2~ 32× mode. At 32× mode, press  again, it will return to normal playing speed. (Same operation to speed down by pressing )

(c) Make pause when playing video/DVR file: press  button, and the video will pause. And if you want to continue playing the video, press  button it will return to normal playing speed.

Note: When there is no TF card inserted ,you can review the pictures in the internal flash, if a TF card inserted , you can view the pictures saved in the TF card.

Delete singe file or folder






At standby state, press  to enter system main menu , press  or  to move the cursor to the target icon . If you want to delete a file or folder, you can select the single file or folder in the list, press and hold the  button for 2 seconds to enter the screen as Figure 3.

Press  or  to choose DELETE, press  to delete the selected file or folder.

Note: Same operation to delete image, audio and DVR files.







System main menu

At standby state, press and hold the  button for 2 seconds to enter the system main menu as Figure 4.







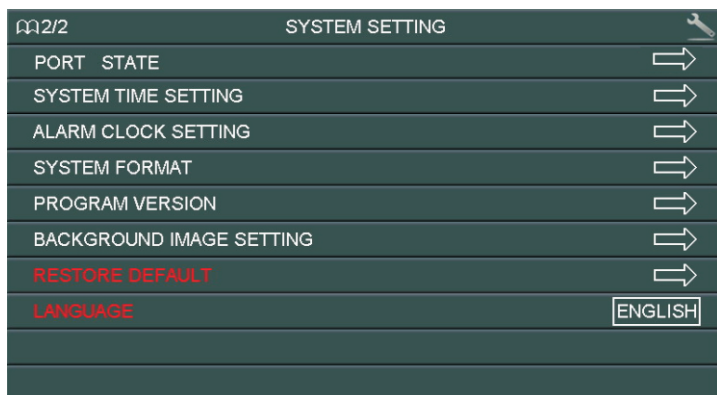

Note:(a)Video recording time shall be different when the recording content is different.(In the worst situation, a 2G card can record pictures of 320*240 resolution ratio at 1 frame per second for 28 hours; In the best situation, the recording time can be over 72 hours.)

(b)If users record the system tone in their own language and copy it into the TF card, we suggest the duration time be less than 20 seconds, otherwise, when the system format TF card, the files would be deleted.
